Project Name in the FY23 JES: Acquisition of Property for the Revitalization of Clifftondale Square Business District

Recipient in the FY23 JES: Town of Saugus

Project Purpose as originally requested in Legi-Mate: The Town of Saugus is interested in revitalizing a longstanding commercial district in the center of Saugus – historically known as Clifftondale. The area has been an important commercial and retail business district in Saugus for generations but in the past 30 years has gone through documented decline and disinvestment. Clifftondale Square has become an area that the town has invested significant time and money into economic analyses and studies, which have resulted in a 2022 Final report by the Clifftondale Revitalization Committee and 2022 Master Plan detailing economic development initiatives and plans to revitalize this commercial district.

Request for technical change: The FY23 JES project name should be changed to “Revitalization of Clifftondale Square Business District”
