Homeland Security

Federal Emergency Management Agency, Pre-Disaster Mitigation Projects

- Requested projects must meet the eligibility requirements of the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant program, including the cost-share requirement, benefit-cost ratio, and environmental and historic preservation requirements. Full requirements can be found in the fiscal year 2022 <u>NOFO for the "Pre-Disaster</u> <u>Mitigation Grant Program</u>" (the Notice of Funding Opportunity for FY23 projects is expected to be issued in the coming weeks, but requirements are unlikely to change).
- For any projects designated for funding in the final fiscal year 2024 Homeland Security Appropriations Act, the state agency responsible for administering mitigation grants in the requestor's state must submit an application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and that entity will serve as the administrative agent for the grant.
- All project proposals must be accompanied by a letter of support from the appropriate state agency affirming that it believes the project is eligible.

Federal Emergency Management Agency Emergency Operations Center Grant Program

- Requested projects must meet the eligibility requirements of the Emergency Operations Center grant program, including the non-federal cost-share requirement and environmental and historic preservation requirements. Full requirements can be found in the fiscal year <u>2022 NOFO for the "Emergency Operations Center Grant Program</u> (the Notice of Funding Opportunity for FY23 projects is expected to be issued in the coming weeks, but requirements are unlikely to change).
- All project proposals must be accompanied by a letter of support from the appropriate state administrative agency affirming that it believes the project is eligible
