SUBJECT: Letter from U.S. Senators Boxer and Markey dated March 31, 2015

On March 31, 2015, I received an email from Tracy Stone-Manning with the attached letter addressed to the Governor requesting response to the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act survey. The Committee on Environment and Public Works is evaluating several asbestos related federal acts this session and their 20-question survey deals with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). In Montana, AHERA is regulated by EPA Region 8 out of Denver, thus the questions designed for State primacy on the topic are not easily answered. However, I queried the three Montana work units most able to provide input and thank the following for their time and effort to respond: Annette Satterly, Montana School Board Association (MSBA); Deb Grimm, Montana Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) Asbestos Control Program (ACP); Chad Anderson, MDEQ Enforcement Division.

Below you will find the questions as asked in the March 31 U.S. Senate letter, followed with **Montana's combined program response**.

Scope of Asbestos Hazards in Schools:

1. How many local education agencies in your state are subject to AHERA? Please provide a list of the local education agencies subject to AHERA and identify the number of school buildings in each.
We view all local education agencies within the state to be subject to AHERA. MSBA has included a spreadsheet of all of the public schools as recognized by OPI and the number of school buildings under their control.
2. How many local education agencies (LEAs) in your state have conducted an initial asbestos inspection of all buildings owned, leased, or used as school buildings as required by AHERA?
Montana DEQ provided MSBA the original inspections that DEQ had housed approximately four years ago. MSBA attached a spreadsheet that outlines the reports that they have in their system.
3. How many local education agencies in your state have been identified as having school buildings that harbor asbestos-containing materials? Please provide a list of those local education agencies and provide the number of school buildings in each that have been identified as harboring asbestos-containing building materials.
Due to Montana DEQ's interpretation of the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) standard, the knowledge that the U.S. has partially overturned the asbestos ban and some asbestos containing material can still be produced and purchased in the country, all of our school buildings are believed to have the potential to harbor asbestos. Since

the U.S. signed the North America Free Trade Act (NAFTA) into law in 1993, which allows many asbestos-containing products to be imported into the country, we truly do not view any school as being asbestos free. If a school is going to conduct renovation, demolition, etc. where 3 square feet or 3 linear feet are going to be disturbed, the material must first be sampled by an accredited asbestos inspector to determine the presence of asbestos.

Awareness and Monitoring of Asbestos Hazards in Schools:

4. How frequently do local education agencies report AHERA compliance information to the State?
The LEAs do not report AHERA compliance information to the state. This information is housed at each individual district.

5. How many local education agencies in your state have prepared and submitted asbestos operation and management (O&M) plans as required by AHERA regulations (40 C.F.R. §763.91)?
All of the original O&M plans were submitted to the state in the late 1980's and early 1990's. These records were given to the asbestos inspector at the MSBA. The schools have kept all of these records on-site since the early 1990's; however, to our knowledge, there is no master list.

6. How many local education agencies in your state have prepared and submitted asbestos management plans as required by AHERA regulations (40 C.F.R. §763.93)?
A list of the original plans has been included with this document (See Question 2 attachment).

7. How many local education agencies in your state have conducted the periodic inspections as required by AHERA regulations? Please provide a list of those local education agencies and the number of school buildings in each for which periodic inspections have not been conducted.
All of the schools that use the re-inspection program provided by the MSBA have a designated staff person who conducts the periodic surveillance for the district every six months. The periodic surveillances are kept with the management plans at the district level and we are not aware of a master list.

8. How often does your State conduct inspections and/or audits of each local education agency for their compliance with AHERA? Please provide the dates of state inspections and/or audits since 2010.
All of the schools that take advantage of the service provided by the MSBA are inspected/re-inspected every three years. Dates of the last inspection are included on the provided spreadsheet.

9. For each of the past five (5) years, what were the annual costs of your State's implementation and enforcement of AHERA?
Inspection/re-inspection costs are included in the price the district pays for workers compensation (the inspection is one of the services offered through this program). Training companies and the abatement companies are better able to provide specific cost estimates for their services in this area. A list of these providers is located at:

10. Have any local education agencies in your state been issued penalties for noncompliance with AHERA? If so, please describe these occasions.

Montana DEQ has not issued any penalties based on noncompliance with AHERA. Our federal counterparts at EPA Region 8 also provided input and indicate that they have not issued penalties or emergency orders, although EPA has leveraged the cooperation of County Superintendents and the Montana Board of Education to bring reluctant LEA's into compliance. In one case, EPA persuaded the local school board and the tribal council to shut down a high school until air testing confirmed it was safe for students and staff.

11. Has your State ever taken an emergency action against any local education agencies for noncompliance with AHERA? If so, please describe these occasions and their outcomes.
Montana DEQ has not taken any emergency action against any local education agency based on noncompliance with AHERA.
12. How many complaints or informant tips about alleged AHERA violations has your state received from parents, teachers, students, janitorial staff, etc. each year since AHERA became law in 1986?
All school-related asbestos complaints filed with Montana DEQ since 1997 has been reviewed; the number of AHERA-related (directly or indirectly) complaints filed by people potentially with school interests (parents, school employees, etc.) was 8.

Asbestos Abatement Status:

13. Of the local education agencies known to have or have had buildings with asbestos-containing material, how many local education agencies have completed full abatement of the asbestos hazards? By "full abatement" we mean full removal of the asbestos hazards and not management in place through encapsulation, enclosure, or other means.
- Please provide a list of the local education agencies that have completed full abatement and the date upon which the abatement was completed.
 - Please provide a list of those local education agencies that have not fully abated known asbestos hazards and the number of school buildings in each that continue to harbor asbestos-containing materials
- The state of Montana does not view any building as being truly "asbestos free" or fully abated because if there is to be a project that disturbs 3 square feet or 3 linear feet, all of the material must first be sampled for the presence of asbestos. Please see response to question #3.**

Asbestos Accreditation, Training, and Licensure:

14. Did your State adopt the EPA's Model Accreditation Plan (i.e., the EPA's template establishing definitions, training, examinations, continuing education, qualifications, recordkeeping, deaccreditation, reciprocity, and electronic reporting as set forth in 40 C.F.R. Pt. 763, SubPt. E, App. C) to ensure contractors, inspectors, and other professionals are adequately trained to handle asbestos-containing materials safely? If not, please describe the differences of your State's accreditation plan as compared with EPA's.
Montana's DEQ Asbestos Control Program (ACP) did adopt EPA's Model Accreditation Plan.
15. How does your State verify that professionals conducting asbestos-related work (such as building inspections, abatement projects, etc.) are properly accredited?
To assure professionals conducting asbestos-related work in Montana are properly accredited, ACP has established Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM), specifically ARM 17.74.362 Accreditation Requirements for Asbestos-Related Occupations (1) Pursuant to 75-

2-511, MCA, a person may not: (a) engage in an asbestos-related occupation unless accredited in that occupation by the department; or (b) contract with or employ in an asbestos-related occupation a person not accredited in that occupation by the department. (2) A person seeking initial accreditation in an asbestos-related occupation shall: (a) successfully complete either a training course approved by the department pursuant to this subchapter, or a course approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and shall pass an examination approved by the department; and (b) submit to the department a completed application form provided by the department, with the fee required in ARM 17.74.402 and a copy of a certificate of satisfactory completion from the course approved for that occupation. (3) The department may deny, suspend, or revoke accreditation of a person pursuant to 75-2-515, MCA. (History: 75-2-503, MCA; IMP, 75-2-511, MCA; NEW, 2006 MAR p. 1574, Eff. 6/23/06.)

The ACP also verifies that asbestos professionals are accredited to perform asbestos-related work in the State, by confirming the professionals listed on an asbestos application are currently accredited. The ACP, while conducting an on-site inspection of an asbestos project, requires asbestos professionals to show the inspector their current accreditation card.

16. In addition to AHERA requirements for accreditation of contractors and laboratories, does your State require any professionals to be licensed to perform asbestos-related work? If so, please describe the requirements for licensure, penalties for doing asbestos-related work without a license, and disciplinary procedures for not performing asbestos-related work in conformity with professional standards in your State. Provide appropriate citations to State statutes when applicable.

Montana's DEQ ACP does not require any professionals to be additionally licensed to perform asbestos-related work. The professionals must be accredited as described under #15.

Asbestos Notifications to Parents, Teachers, and Staff:

17. Does your State have a template notification letter for use by local education agencies to provide parents, teachers, and staff annual notifications about asbestos management plans? If so, please provide a copy.

Montana doesn't have a copy of the template because the schools use a template provided by EPA to notify parents, teachers, and staff about the presence of asbestos within the buildings.

18. How many local education agencies have provided annual notification letters to parents, teachers, and staff each year since 2010?

- a. Please provide a list of the local education agencies that have provided annual notification letters to parents, teachers, and staff each year since 2010.
- b. Please provide a list of the local education agencies that have not provided annual notification letters to parents, teachers, and staff each year since 2010.

All of the districts that work with the MSBA provide this letter. The letter is usually included in the school's handbook; some use their webpages, while others have used the local newspaper for this function. MSBA does not have a master list available for this.

Reporting to EPA:

19. What information related to AHERA and asbestos hazards in schools does your State report to the

EPA? How frequently does this reporting occur?

Neither MSBA nor MDEQ report to EPA. The schools fill out a questionnaire for EPA approximately every 2 years. The questionnaire is sent directly to the school district by the EPA Region 8 Office in Denver.

20. Does your State receive grant funding to assist in the enforcement of AHERA (e.g., funding to conduct inspections)? If so, please describe the funding amount, funding period, and reporting requirements.

AHERA in Montana is administered through EPA Region 8 in Denver. MDEQ does not receive grant money, nor assume primacy for AHERA.
