Trump's First 100 Days in Office
Senator Edward J. Markey (D-Mass.)

In his first 100 days, Donald Trump:

1. Propped up Big Tech billionaires at his inauguration.
2. Withdrew the U.S. from the World Health Organization (WHO).
3. Pulled the U.S. out of the Paris climate agreement.
4. Created the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE).
5. Called for an end to birthright citizenship via an executive order, which is unlawful because an executive order cannot override the Constitution.
6. Canceled nearly \$400 million in funding to support communities' efforts to eliminate or reduce flood damage.
7. Eliminated the Office of Climate Change and Health Equity which addresses green-house gas (GHG) emissions from the health sector and facilitates interagency coordination to address climate change impacts on public health.
8. Attacked clean car regulations that save drivers money at the pump.
9. Unleashed Immigrations and Customs Enforcement (ICE) at schools, hospitals, and churches.
10. Disbanded the Office of Gun Violence Prevention, which championed the first federal gun safety legislation in more than 30 years.
11. Repealed the Biden administration's artificial intelligence (AI) protections for minority communities.
12. Helped states refuse abortion care in life-threatening emergencies.
13. Threatened to take over the Panama Canal.

14. Fired 18 inspectors general who work to eliminate government waste, fraud, and abuse.
15. Threatened to hold California wildfire aid hostage.
16. Threatened to use military action against Greenland to take it by force and violate its sovereignty.
17. Illegally fired two National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) officials.
18. Banned transgender Americans from serving in the military.
19. Restricted access to gender affirming care.
20. Froze Clean School Bus Rebate Funding, standing in the way of keeping our air clean for kids.
21. Spread misinformation about vaccines and risked the health of millions of Americans.
22. Blamed a plane crash on “DEI.”
23. Eliminated the public records office at the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).
24. Scrubbed health data related to HIV from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) website.
25. Allowed DOGE access to sensitive Treasury Department information.
26. Fired the director of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) because Trump favors the interests of his billionaire buddies over those of American consumers.
27. Guttled federal protections for worker safety.
28. Scrubbed the mention of “climate change” from agency websites.
29. Froze \$10 billion in disaster funding as part of a bogus investigation into nonprofit support for undocumented immigrants.
30. Cut cancer research funding.
31. Cut diabetes research funding.
32. Cut HIV/AIDS research funding.

33. Cut heart disease research funding.
34. Cut mental health research funding.
35. Cut family caregiving research funding.
36. Cut funding to recruit the next generation of health researchers, putting years of innovation at risk.
37. Withdrew grant opportunities with the Office on Violence Against Women.
38. Threatened providers, hospitals, and community health centers because of the type of care they provide.
39. Froze funding for community health centers.
40. Ordered the suspension of electric vehicle (EV) charging funding.
41. Tried to rename the Gulf of Mexico.
42. Illegally rescinded \$80 million in congressional-appropriated Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funding from NYC bank accounts.
43. Fired (and then rehired) over 300 staffers at the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), jeopardizing the security of the U.S. nuclear stockpile.
44. Threatened to take over Canada.
45. Weakened the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) by cozying up to Russia and alienating allies.
46. Cut Alzheimer's research funding, delaying breakthroughs that could find a cure for this tragic and deadly disease.
47. Terminated the American Climate Corps.
48. Cut hundreds of employees from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).
49. Fired more than 200 probationary FEMA workers.
50. Fired more than 2,400 National Park Service workers nationwide, including at Minuteman National Park, Springfield Armory, and Cape Cod National Seashore.
51. Called to privatize the United States Postal Service, jeopardizing jobs and the fast, safe, and efficient delivery of our mail.

52. Fired workers responsible for answering the Veterans' Administration (VA) Crisis Line.
53. Worked with Republicans in Congress to gut Medicaid.
54. Terminated hundreds of VA contracts, including those in cancer research and suicide prevention.
55. Fired more than 1,000 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) employees nationwide.
56. Gutted the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) and halted global humanitarian assistance.
57. Fired 2,400 VA employees, with plans to cut 80,000 more.
58. Froze funding and cancelled classes at the National Fire Academy.
59. Canceled the Local Food for Schools and Local Purchase Assistance Programs at the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), ending subsidies that go directly to farmers to provide fresh food for schools and costing Massachusetts farmers \$18 million.
60. Ordered the closure of environmental justice offices at the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) headquarters and regional offices.
61. Froze and announced termination of Climate Bank funding, which helps leverage private capital to create jobs, cut energy bills for families, strengthen our energy independence, and combat the climate crisis.
62. Froze \$20 million in Community Change Grant Funding to improve air quality in Springfield, MA – the former asthma capital of the nation – and cut another \$1 million from Massachusetts Department of Public Health to combat asthma rates in Western Massachusetts.
63. Eliminated the Institute of Museum and Library Services.
64. Wiped the surgeon general's advisory calling gun violence a public health crisis.

65. Called for the firing of federal judges who have disagreed with him, which would clearly violate the Constitution.
66. Illegally fired the Democratic Commissioners at the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).
67. Cut off legal representation for unaccompanied children in immigration proceedings.
68. Cut funding to fight the opioid epidemic.
69. Threatened to block a media merger if CBS didn't change its reporting.
70. Gave DOGE access to Sensitive Small Business Administration (SBA) Data.
71. Signal Gate – Trump administration defense and security officials shared national security information over messaging app Signal.
72. Abducted Tufts graduate student Rümeyşa Öztürk.
73. Cut funding that help kids get vaccinated.
74. Terminated collective bargaining for thousands of federal workers.
75. Called to end funding for public broadcasters.
76. Cut off \$106 million in education funds for Massachusetts.
77. Threatened a military attack against Iran, which could set off a full-blown regional war in the Middle East.
78. Fired nearly all Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) federal staff.
79. Fired 870 workers at the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health – approximately two-thirds of their workforce.
80. Cut Funding for Head Start.
81. Canceled more than a thousand National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) grants, totaling more than \$363 million.
82. Delayed broadband grant funding.
83. Allowed a measles epidemic to spread uncontrolled.

84. Eliminated more than \$880 million in federal climate resilience aid that helps communities build disaster resilient infrastructure.
85. Opened America's public lands to coal mining.
86. Targeted state and local laws aimed at tackling the climate crisis.
87. Moved to end life-saving parole programs for Afghans, Ukrainians, Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans.
88. Moved to sunset critical environmental regulations.
89. Blocked \$2.2 billion in federal grant funding to Harvard.
90. Froze public safety grants for public broadcasters.
91. Halted federal leasing and permitting for wind projects.
92. Gutted permitting processes in order to fast-track dirty energy projects to reward his Big Oil and Coal Cronies.
93. Canceled \$90 million in disaster prevention funding to Massachusetts.
94. Put all staff on the U.S. Interagency Council on Homelessness on administrative leave, essentially shutting down the agency.
95. Suspended food safety inspections after firing Food and Drug Administration (FDA) workers.
96. Terminated \$400 million in grants for AmeriCorps.
97. Suspended refugee resettlement.
98. Arrested Judge Hannah Dugan, alleging she helped an undocumented man avoid immigration enforcement.
99. Increased funding for the Sentinel Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) program which, as it increases the risk of accidental launch of nuclear weapons, makes nuclear war more likely.
100. Deported children who are United States citizens.
