To authorize appropriations for highway-rail grade crossing improvement projects.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Warren Cowles Grade

5 Crossing Safety Act".

6 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR HIGH-

7 WAY-RAIL GRADE CROSSING IMPROVEMENT
8 PROJECTS.

9 Section 22907 of title 49, United States Code, is
10 amended—

1	(1) in subsection $(c)(5)$, by inserting ", includ-
2	ing such a project for commuter rail and operators
3	in high-ridership corridors" before the period at the
4	end; and
5	(2) by adding at the end the following:
6	"(m) Authorization of Appropriations.—
7	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section
8	22905(f), there are authorized to be appropriated
9	for eligible projects described in subsection $(c)(5)$ for
10	commuter rail and operators in high-ridership cor-
11	ridors—
12	"(A) for fiscal year 2021, \$250,000,000;
13	and
14	"(B) for fiscal year 2022 and each fiscal
15	year thereafter, the amount described in para-
16	graph (2).
17	"(2) Amount described.—The amount de-
18	scribed in this paragraph for a fiscal year is
19	\$250,000,000, adjusted to reflect the percentage (if
20	any) of the increase in the average of the Consumer
21	Price Index for the preceding 12-month period com-
22	pared to the Consumer Price Index for fiscal year
23	2020.
24	"(3) Consumer price index defined.—In
25	this subsection, the term 'Consumer Price Index'

means the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Con sumers published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics
 of the Department of Labor.".
