**A BILL**

To provide for the issuance of an Alzheimer’s Disease Research Semipostal Stamp.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ALZHEIMER’S DISEASE RESEARCH**  
4 **SEMIPOSTAL STAMP.**

5 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term  
6 “semipostal stamp” has the meaning given the term  
7 “semipostal” in section 416(a)(1) of title 39, United  
8 States Code.

9 (b) ISSUANCE.—In order to afford a convenient way  
10 for members of the public to contribute to funding for

1 medical research relating to Alzheimer’s disease, the  
2 United States Postal Service shall issue a semipostal  
3 stamp (referred to in this section as the “Alzheimer’s Dis-  
4 ease Research Semipostal Stamp”) in accordance with  
5 subsection (c).

6 (c) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in this  
8 subsection, the issuance and sale of the Alzheimer’s  
9 Disease Research Semipostal Stamp shall be gov-  
10 erned by section 416 of title 39, United States Code,  
11 and regulations issued under that section.

12 (2) DURATION.—The Alzheimer’s Disease Re-  
13 search Semipostal Stamp shall be made available to  
14 the public for a period of 6 years, beginning not  
15 later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this  
16 Act.

17 (3) DISPOSITION OF PROCEEDS.—All amounts  
18 becoming available from the sale of the Alzheimer’s  
19 Disease Research Semipostal Stamp (as determined  
20 under section 416(d) of title 39, United States  
21 Code) shall be transferred to the National Institutes  
22 of Health, for the purpose described in subsection  
23 (b), through payments which shall be made not less  
24 frequently than 2 times a year.

1           (4) LIMITATION.—For purposes of section 416  
2           of title 39, United States Code (including any regu-  
3           lation prescribed under subsection (e)(1)(C) of that  
4           section), the semipostal stamp issued under this sec-  
5           tion shall not apply to any limitation relating to  
6           whether more than 1 semipostal stamp may be of-  
7           fered for sale at the same time.
