A BILL

To designate a portion of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge as wilderness.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Arctic Refuge Protec-
5 tion Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF PORTION OF ARCTIC NATIONAL**
7 **WILDLIFE REFUGE AS WILDERNESS.**

8 Section 4 of the National Wildlife Refuge System Ad-
9 ministration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd) is amended
10 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(p) DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN LAND AS WILDER-
2 NESS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act,
3 a portion of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge in Alaska
4 comprising approximately 1,559,538 acres, as generally
5 depicted on the map entitled ‘Arctic National Wildlife Ref-
6 uge, Coastal Plain Proposed Wilderness’, dated October
7 20, 2015, labeled with Map ID 03–0172, and available
8 for inspection in the offices of the Secretary, is designated
9 as a component of the National Wilderness Preservation
10 System under the Wilderness Act (16 U.S.C. 1131 et
11 seq.).”.
