3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Save the Internet Act

1	SEC. 2. RESTORATION OF OPEN INTERNET ORDER.
2	(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—
3	(1) the term "Commission" means the Federal
4	Communications Commission; and
5	(2) the term "rule" has the meaning given the
6	term in section 804 of title 5, United States Code.
7	(b) REPEAL OF RULE.—The Declaratory Ruling, Re-
8	port and Order, and Order in the matter of restoring
9	internet freedom that was adopted by the Commission on
10	December 14, 2017 (FCC 17–166) shall have no force or
11	effect.
12	(c) Prohibition on Reissued Rule or New
13	RULE.—The Commission may not reissue the Declaratory
14	Ruling, Report and Order, and Order described in sub-
15	section (b) in substantially the same form, or issue a new
16	rule that is substantially the same as that Declaratory
17	Ruling, Report and Order, and Order, unless the reissued
18	or new rule is specifically authorized by a law enacted
