AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MARKEY

Viz:

1 At the end of section 2, add the following:

2 (f) LIMITATION.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
4 none of the crude oil and bitumen transported into
5 the United States by the operation of the Keystone
6 XL pipeline under the authority provided by sub-
7 section (a), and none of the refined petroleum fuel
8 products originating from that crude oil or bitumen,
9 may be exported from the United States.

10 (2) WAIVERS AUTHORIZED.—The President
11 may waive the limitation described in paragraph (1)
12 if—

1 (A) the President determines that a waiver
2 is in the national interest because it—

3 (i) will not lead to an increase in do-
4 mestic consumption of crude oil or refined
5 petroleum products obtained from coun-
6 tries hostile to United States' interests or
7 with political and economic instability that
8 compromises energy supply security;

9 (ii) will not lead to higher costs to re-
10 finers who purchase the crude oil than the
11 refiners would pay for crude oil in the ab-
12 sence of the waiver; and

13 (iii) will not lead to higher gasoline
14 costs to consumers than consumers would
15 pay in the absence of the waiver;

16 (B) an exchange of crude oil or refined
17 product provides for no net loss of crude oil or
18 refined product consumed domestically; or

19 (C) a waiver is necessary under the Con-
20 stitution, a law, or an international agreement.
