West Virginia's Dept. of Education has conducted workshops and provided guidance to school districts regarding the requirements of the Act. Training also has been provided and continues to be provided.

All school districts are aware that they are required to maintain and update their asbestos management plans each year, and this requirement is checked during the annual inspections that the WV Dept. of Education, Office of School Facilities, conducts of the schools through-out the state to ensure that the county boards and schools do, in fact, update their plans, as required.

Finally, a master plan for all schools is maintained at the board office, and every school is required to maintain an updated plan for that particular school.
