## SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FROM FEDERAL JURIES ON ACCOUNT OF DISABILITY.

6 (b) QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE.—Section
7 1865 of title 28, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (b)(4), by striking "infirmity"
9 inserting "disability that cannot be reasonably ac10 commodated"; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

"(c) No person may be disqualified from serving on
grand and petit juries in the district court under paragraph (2) or (3) of subsection (b) on account of disability
if the person would be qualified under such paragraph (2)
or (3) by reasonable accommodation.".
