1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Net Neutrality and5 Broadband Justice Act of 2022".

6 SEC. 2. CLASSIFICATION OF BROADBAND AS TELE-7 COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE.

8 Section 3(53) of the Communications Act of 1934
9 (47 U.S.C. 153(53)) is amended—

6	"(B) includes the offering of broadband
7	internet access service, as defined in section

9	classes of users as to be effectively available di-
10	rectly to the public, regardless of the facilities
